Andrey Morozov was a student of the military law Academy in 1940. He participated in pre-war parades on Red Square. He was a participant in the annexation of Bessarabia to the USSR.




The Beginning of the War

In 1941. A. S. Morozov went to the front as a volunteer in the 1st Communist regiment. He participated in the battles of Vyazma. There, he was able to save his sons, who were 8 years old and 2.5 years old, from death. At the beginning of the war, his sons were visiting their grandmother in the village of Ovsvaniki near Vvazma.



The Battle on the Outskirts of Moscow

The battle began on October 2, and on October 7, German troops surrounded the Soviet Army. It was only on October 12 that they managed to escape the encirclement for a short time, which soon resumed.



The «Vyazemsky cauldron»

Vyazma was under occupation until the liberation of Stalingrad. The «Vyazemsky cauldron» was one of the most disastrous defeats of the Red Army during the Great Patriotic War, and there were only few survivors.



In the Service of our Country

By order of Stalin, A. S. Morozov was recalled from the front to fight crime as an investigator. He did not become a Hero, did not receive awards, but he believed that he honestly fulfilled his duty to the Motherland.
